I was born in New York City, 1925. I married Mildred in 1952, and have two sons.

In 1969 I became the Director of The Children's Aid Society's Visual Arts Center on Sullivan Street in Greenwich Village, New York. As well as administrating the program, I enjoyed teaching painting and drawing to both children and adults until my retirement in 1999.

My paintings represent work in oil paint and mixed media, using images in an attempt to concretize a world of highly personal mythology. I have also created highly glazed, imaginative

and mythological portraits of animals, as well as expressionistic landscapes and self-portraits.

I became interested in doing book art in the 1960s, attempting to create an intimate use of imagery. The process has continued to this day, and it has included what I believe to be some of my most personal imagery. These books are influenced by medieval illustrated manuscripts, creating jewel-like drawings imbued with a modern sensibility and with the use of line drawings, as well as collage. These books are reminiscent of gothic imagery.
